



Statement from Sullivan County School District Regarding Sanitation

Mr. McMahon, Director of Maintenance

The maintenance and custodial staff have been sanitizing the entire Sullivan County School District facility to maintain a healthy and safe environment for all students and employees. This is our commitment to the students to enable us to have them in school on a daily basis.

The process in place to maintain health and safety is that all surfaces that are touched are sanitized and disinfected as much as possible during period changes. Classroom desks are disinfected by staff as needed. At selected times during the day, maintenance disinfects lunch tables, door handles, bathrooms, lockers, and hand rails. At the end of the day, the 2nd shift custodial staff repeats the process in more detail after students go home. This ensures a sanitized facility for the next day.

The disinfectant chosen for use is Hillyard QT3 #43. This product is safe for use in these applications. It is registered with the Environmental Protection Agency and with the Center for Disease Control guidelines list of disinfectants for use against SARS-Co-V2 (Covid-19). Hillyard QT3 #43 is rated as a Covid-19 eliminator in a 5min stand time. The product is used in a diluted form dispensed from a metered dispenser at 1 oz. per gallon of water. In addition, Hillyard QT3 #43 has the same active ingredients as most of the disinfecting wipes that we all use on a daily basis. Finally, gloves have been distributed to all rooms to use if they choose to use them.
