Sullivan County School District Phased Reopening Covid-19 Pandemic

2020-2021

Buildings

- CDC and Department of Health Guidelines are followed
- Air Filters (8 merv) with outside air circulating –
- Cleaning and sanitizing solutions – following the recommendations working with Hillyard
- Job lists with check off sheets
- Routine cleaning increased with frequently contact areas cleaned more frequently
- Fogger will be used in the evening
- Water fountains will **not** be in use –
- Water bottler fillers are located in each building

Classrooms

- Desks are socially distanced
- Each room will have hand sanitizer & spray disinfectant with cloth
- Elementary students will have a box filled with their individual school supplies
- Elementary students will stay in their classrooms but for lunch and recess
- Specials will come to their classes
- High School students will rotate classes
- High School will follow place markers in the hallway and move in one direction



Face covering

- Clear Face coverings will be required by Staff *
- When will face coverings will be required by Students?*
- On the bus
- In school when social distancing cannot happen
 - Examples: hallways

Buses

- Face coverings must be worn on the buses

Lunch & Recess

Elementary and High School will eat in the cafeteria

- Elementary overflow will eat in classrooms
- High School overflow will eat in the gym

Elementary Recess will be one grade level out at a time in specified spots



*A Doctor's excuse will be required for those that state they are unable to wear a mask when required

Self monitoring

- Parents must self-monitor their children before leaving for school
- Keep children home if sick and temperature 100.4 or above
- Staff must self-monitor before coming to work
- Stay home and use sick time if sick and/or temperature is 100.4 or above

What if the school is notified that a Student or Staff member has been Identified with COVID-19?

- The area used by a person testing positive for COVID-19 will be closed off and not use until cleaned, disinfected and sanitized
- The School will notify staff and families of the confirmed case while maintaining confidentiality
- School Districts are still waiting on further guidance from PDE for the next steps



Sullivan County's Continuity of Education Plan (Revised)

(Educational plan used in times of emergency when online remote learning is necessary)

Review and Enrichment (used in March)

Planned Instruction (current) required criteria with instruction

- Attendance will be taken
- Material will be graded and students will receive grades
- Continue with Curriculum and course work

The District is committed to providing families and students Sullivan County instruction that is designed to build upon the learning established within the District. Options available for families:

1. Classroom Instruction led by Sullivan County classroom teachers face-to-face in school (Option 1)

We are ready for School to Open on August 20th!

2. Virtual instruction led by Sullivan County classroom teachers with materials provided, attendance taken, and grades received as if they are sitting in the classroom with classmates (Option 2)

- named Griffin Virtual Academy
- Strongly recommended for families that are apprehensive about sending their child due to the pandemic
- Child will stay on track with academics with their classes and classmates
- All guidelines will be followed
- Easy transition when families decide to send their child back to the brick and mortar (option 1)
- More information will be coming if this is the option you are choosing
- This is the option Sullivan County School District will use if/when the District must close due to emergency situations
